- <u>Senate Bill No. 2171</u>, which <u>provides</u> for the Public Employees Retirement System (PERS) to provide an optional health benefits plan
- <u>Senate Bill No. 2239</u>, which <u>provides</u> for actuarially determined employer contribution rates for the PERS defined benefit retirement plan
